Admission to Upper Division for students majoring in Health and Physical Education requirements are: (1) Completion of all Freshmen courses; (2) Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher; (3) Passing scores on all 3 sections of Praxis I (PPST or Core Academic Skills) or an ACT waiver of a composite score of 22 or higher.
